Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "SHINTO MARU", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Kobe now report that you do not intend to submit this vessel for completion of Special Survey No. 2 required by the Society's Rules for the maintenance of her class, and I have to say that in the circumstances and in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the completion of this inspection expired at the end of August last, the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled, and should be returned either to this Office or the Society's Surveyors at Kobe.
