The S.S. No.2, due 8,27, has been partly held by the ^{Testing} examination of the fore and after peak tanks and testing of Nos. 1, 2, 5 & 6 double bottom tanks.

The Kobe Surveyors now state they have been informed by the Owners that it has been decided to withdraw the classification from the Society's Register Book and that the steamer has now been classed with the British Corporation and Teikoku Kaiji Kyokai.

The Surveyors recommend that as the year of grace has expired the vessel's class be expunged with a red line.

The year of grace expired 8,28.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
