With reference to your letter of the 4th April 1921 regarding the steamer "SHINTO MARU", I beg to state that the following has now been fitted:-

- (1) Panting stringer  $17\frac{1}{2}'' \times \frac{1}{2}''$  with shell angle  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}'' \times \frac{1}{2}''$  stringer angle  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}'' \times \frac{1}{2}''$  and Face angle  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}'' \times \frac{1}{2}''$  extending from collision bulkhead to frame 117 P & S.
- (2) Side stiffeners  $7'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}'' \times \frac{3}{8}''$  bulb angle to bulkheads No. 51 and 71 bracketed to horizontal brackets, and at top.
- (3) All tween deck bulkhead stiffeners - bracketed to second deck.
