
Before this case receives the consideration of the Committee Mr. Jones should be requested to state whether, in addition to the strengthening at ends of bridge given in report, the other requirements in the Secretary's Cable of the 1st April 1919 have been carried out, as it is not clear from report or plans forwarded whether this is so.

These requirements are, Panting stringer to extend to frame 117, Mast to be supported to the Surveyor's satisfaction, Stiffeners to be fitted to Bulkheads 51 & 71 at side of ship, foot of tween deck girder stiffeners at collision bulkhead, and at bulkhead frame No 71 to be braced to deck.

The Surveyors should also state length of Poop.
