Dear Sir,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steam Trawler "AVON", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby, from which it appears that they have been unable to obtain any definite information from your goodself regarding the completion of the Second Special Survey No. 1, which became due on this vessel in July 1923, and the special examination of the screwshaft.

In the circumstances the Committee regret that as no satisfactory arrangements have been made for these surveys to be held, they have now no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have at the same time to add that the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character in the Register Book upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors to the effect that all requisite surveys and repairs have been carried out.
