Dear Sirs,

H. I am in receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the steam trawler "AVON" and have placed the same before the Committee at their Meeting to-day.

The Committee note you have been informed by the Owners' Representative that the vessel will be drydocked in about two months' time, when the screwshaft will be submitted to examination and, in the circumstances, they have deferred consideration of the case until the end of June. The Committee desire me to add, however, that as the survey of the screwshaft and completion of the 2nd Special Survey No.1 are now so long overdue, these matters must receive attention by the end of June in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class. I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
