The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

Nature of Survey

The 2nd.s.s.No.1 due 7,23 has been partly held and to complete the same the wood deck requires to be repaired as necessary.

A proposal to carry out all the necessary surveys on the vessel's next dry docking in about three months' time was agreed to in August last.

The Grimsby Surveyors subsequently stated they had been definitely informed by the Owners that the vessel would be stopped before the end of October, 1924 when the remaining requirements of the special survey would be carried out.

The same Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom cleaned and coated.

Nothing has been done at this time to the wood deck, but the same has been examined and found efficient.

It is stated that the necessary repairs will be effected at the vessel's annual refit in May next.

The year of grace expired 7,24.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
