Dear Sirs,

Reverting to my letter of the 19th instant respecting your tug "LISBUNA", I am directed to acquaint you that the case of this vessel was duly submitted to the General Committee of the Society at their meeting to-day, and in all the circumstances it was decided to expunge the class from the Register Book with a black line, indicating that from reported defects she is no longer entitled to retain her classification.

As already mentioned in my letter of the 19th instant, in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
