Nature of Survey .....

The Kobe Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom etc., examined below the load water line and found in good condition, wear and tear excepted and with the exception that one plate is slightly indented, but in the Surveyors' opinion the efficiency of the vessel is not affected.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, without record of survey.
