On the 31st July last the Queenstown Surveyor stated he hoped the railway facilities would enable him to proceed to Limerick shortly with a view to carrying out the above examination. In the circumstances the Committee deferred consideration of the case for a time.

In reply to enquiry the Queenstown Surveyor now writes:-

"I have to say that in consequence of the dislocation of the Railway and Post Office services it has not hitherto been practicable to arrange for the inspection of the I.P. & L.P. cylinders of this vessel.

"I have, however, learned to-day that it is now possible to travel from Cork to Buttevant by motor charabanc and thence to Limerick by train and, in view of this, I will again communicate with the Owners and arrange

Committee's Minute *FRI. 13 OCT 1922* for the survey to be held in the near future."
