Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had before them at their Meeting to-day a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, from which it appears you have informed them that it is not your desire to maintain the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "DAIFUKU MARU" ex "GONZAGA", and I am directed to say that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled, and if you have not sent these to the Society's Surveyors at Kobe already, they should be returned to this Office.
