
Dear Mr. Mayne:-

In reply to the inquiry contained in your letter of the 11th December in connection with New York Report No. 17520 on the Steamer "KEWANEE", I have to acquaint you that this vessel's class should be without freeboard and also that the thicknesses of the bridge and forecastle deck plating and poop and forecastle side plating are as approved.

The breadth of the lower edge lap of sheerstrake and the diameter of the rivets are also as approved and the workmanship and material are good.

An oiltight bulkhead has been fitted at frame 125 and the number of bulkheads for record in the Register Book is 13.
