Dear Sirs,

I duly received Mr. Brown's letter of the 23rd ultimo submitting for the consideration of the Committee a plan of a boiler built by Messrs. Ansaldo Ltd., which has been purchased by Messrs. M.U. Martinolich of Lussinpiccolo, who intend to fit the same in a vessel being built to class with this Society.

With regard thereto I am directed to inform you that provided the results of the tests of material be in order; the boiler be examined and found in good and safe working condition and its scantlings be in accordance with the plan; the boiler be found tight and satisfactory under an hydraulic test of 23 kilogrammes per square centimetre, and be fitted on board the vessel in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, the same will be accepted, in this instance, for a working pressure of 13 kilogrammes per square centimetre.

The plan forwarded is being returned to your address to-day under separate cover.
