Dear Sir,

S. Reverting to your letter of the 5th January last addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Bordeaux relative to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steam Trawler "MAROC", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had before them a communication from the Society's Principal Surveyor for France, from which it appears that you are unable to re-consider your decision to withdraw the classification of this vessel from the Society's Register Book, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
