I have to inform you that your First Entry Report No. 82513, on the new S.S. "JAMES LAVENNY" has to-day received the consideration of the Classing Committee who have classed the vessel "100 Al. Steam trawler", and have assigned notations of "Lloyd's A & C.P" and "L.M.C. 11:19".

I have to add that it is concluded that the brackets to shell are fitted to bulkheads as approved, and that the aft peak bulkhead extends to the raised quarter deck, but you will be good enough to state whether this is so.
