of the British Corporation Registry.

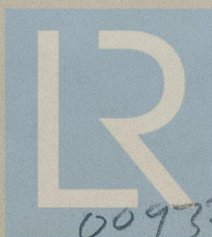
The whole of the work covered by the Specification
