Dear Sir,

With reference to your first entry report on the Steel S.S. "THOMAS LAWRIE", built by Messrs. J. Chambers Ltd., of Lowestoft, I have to inform you that the case received the consideration of the classing committee to-day, and the vessel has been classed "LOCAL Steam Trawler" with notations of "LHC 11.19 and Lloyd's A. & C.P".

In connexion with your recommendation in this case I would point out that the class of this vessel should be "100 A.1 Steam Trawler" and not "For Fishing Purposes".

I have to add that it is concluded the thickness of collision bulkhead stiffeners is as approved, and that liners (or equivalent) have been fitted at bulkhead frames, but I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether this is so.
