This vessel has recently been under survey by the Society's Surveyor at Newport News in consequence of damage caused through collision. Recommendations were made by the Surveyor for repairs, but the vessel was sold and the new Owners stated they had purchased her with a view to using the boilers and machinery in tugs owned by them and converting the hull into a barge. The Surveyor states that the steamer is being repaired but not under his survey and the Owners do not desire to maintain her in the Society's Classification.

The case came before the American Committee on Wednesday, 27th ultimo, when it was decided to withdraw the vessel's class from the Register Book and to insert three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
