Dear Mr. Mann,

May I refer to the remarks contained in your letter of the 4th August last on the subject of the Steamer "GOUVERNEUR GENERAL ROUME" at Saigon?

From a letter which we have received from the Society's Surveyor at Singapore, it appears that the Agents of the vessel state that the steamer was laid up from the 22nd April to the 15th July, 1927, and that a sum of \$50,000 was spent on repairs, and this is alleged to have been done in accordance with "Lloyd's Specialist's" instructions.

It further appears that the screw shaft had been drawn in and examined by "Lloyd's Surveyor".

As we do not appear to have received from you any report regarding the matters alluded to above, I shall be much obliged if you will kindly favour me with any remarks you may consider desirable with a view to elucidating the circumstances.
