

Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "GOUVERNEUR GENERAL ROUME", I have to acquaint you that in November last the Society's Surveyor at Saigon was authorised to carry out the 2nd Special Survey No.3 and particulars of the vessel's scantlings, together with drilling sheets and the usual printed instructions regarding the carrying out of the inspection in question were sent him. At the same time he was requested to cable the results of the drillings to this office as soon as the same had been ascertained.

As you will be aware, Mr. Mann has since resigned his appointment and in a letter dated the 4th instant he states that the Owners are anxious to have the above survey held at Saigon if possible and that they requested him to try and arrange with you for this to be done. Mr. Mann adds that when in Singapore he discussed the matter with you.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will advise me by cablegram of the arrangements which you
