With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "GOUVERNEUR GENERAL ROUME", I beg to acquaint you that in November last year the Society's Surveyor at Saigon was authorised to carry out the Second Special Survey No. 3 which became due on this vessel in October.

Mr. E. A. Mann, the Society's Surveyor at Saigon, has now resigned his appointment, and in the circumstances the Committee will be glad if you will kindly make arrangements for the Second Special Survey No. 3 to be carried out at a port where one of the Society's Surveyors is stationed, the most suitable ports in the vicinity of Saigon being Singapore and Hongkong.

As the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Second Special Survey No. 3 will expire at the end of October next, the Committee hope that you will be able to make early arrangements for the necessary inspection to take place.
