Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 29th September relative to the steamer "GOUVERNEUR GENERAL ROUME", and with regard thereto I have to say that in the circumstances the Committee are agreeable to the Owners' proposal to carry out this inspection at Saigon at as early a date as possible within the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules. The Committee will ~~also~~ authorise you to hold the survey in question in this instance.

With regard to this case I have to state that the Committee rely on your exercising the greatest care to ensure that an exhaustive survey is held, that the whole of the Rules are fully complied with, and that the vessel -after careful opening up and examination as required - is placed in a thoroughly satisfactory state, in order to avoid the possibility of any repairs which should have received attention at the time of your survey being found to be necessary at a future date.

I should add that in any case in which there may be any doubt in your mind as to the repairs necessitated by the condition in which you find a vessel you should at once report the particulars to this Office, with a view to
