Sir,

I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a report from the Society's Surveyors at Dundee on the steamer "VICTORIA" No.218 in the Register Book, from which it appears that the Classification Survey of this vessel has not been fully carried out. Parts of the middle deck in Nos.2 & 3 holds have been temporarily removed for shipping new boilers for the S/S "COGEE" at Melbourne and the deck at these parts has been secured for the voyage to the satisfaction of the Surveyors. The Owners propose to have the deck permanently fastened either at Melbourne or Sydney and the vessel has been classed 100 A1 by the Committee subject to, this being done.

I have therefore to request that in the event of the vessel arriving in your district you will give the matter attention.
