The Boiler Survey became due on this vessel in 8.41 and on the 27th September her name appeared on the Statutory Black List. Before any action was taken by the Committee in regard thereto, a report was received from the Society's Surveyor at Valparaiso of Boiler Survey held at that port in August/September last, and after discussion the Committee agreed that a notation of this inspection should be made in the Register Book seeing that it was held prior to her being blacklisted.

Under date of the 1st October the Society's Surveyor at Valparaiso states that the fees and expenses for this inspection have not been paid. He adds that it appears the Owners are on the Black List and that their insurance policy has been cancelled and the matter has been left without definite promise of payment.

The case is, therefore, resubmitted for the consideration of the Committee.
