Messrs, Kernode's Lin., Liverpool, attend at the works of Messrs, W. H. Baker, Lin., Clayton Street, Wigan, on Tuesday 14th December 1926 for the purpose of inspecting oil fuel appliances for Cochrane Boilers intended for Messrs, Mitsubishi Shoji Kaisha's Motor Vessels No. 427.

The parts and arrangements, as detailed below, were found in accordance with the approved plan and tested in compliance with Lloyd's Rules, to 400 lb./sq. inch and found tight and satisfactory.

Each Set:- One "Galver Burner" with swing cocks, steam and oil pipes, valves, pressure gauge, tee piece and oil cocks.

One single plunger hand pump with cocks, and flexible pipe 10'-0" long, lighting up burner with small spool and disc.

Spare gear, each set:- One "Galva Burner" and one lighting up burner.
