With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the motor tug "CALTANURA", and to the Modified Survey, which became due on the vessel's Oil Engines in July last, I have to acquaint you I am now advised by the Society's Surveyors in New York that the Owners are making arrangements with their Representative Mr. F. W. Ohliger (California Arabian Standard Oil Co., Bahrein Island, Persian Gulf) to have the necessary inspection carried out at your port. As the Society has no Surveyor stationed in your district, I shall be obliged if you will kindly appoint a competent and independent Surveyor to carry out the survey on behalf of this Society.

For your information and guidance, I enclose an extract from the Society's rules dealing with the requirements for the survey in question and a Report Form which should be returned to this Office duly completed.

I think it well to add that all fees and expenses in connection with this matter are payable by the Owners or their Representatives and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
