Referring to your letter of the 7th January last enclosing a copy of a letter dated 2nd December, which you had received from the Owners of the Motor Tug "CALTANURA" which is in service in the Persian Gulf, I may say that the matter has been taken up with the California Arabian Standard Oil Company, who are agreeable to arranging for the Modified Survey of the Oil Engines to be carried out by a Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agents.
