The class is subject to indented plating in E strake on port and starboard sides being dealt with at the Owners' convenience and damaged bulwark plating on port side repaired at the first opportunity.

The Dunkirk Surveyor now reports that the port bulwark has been repaired.

The Surveyor recommends that the indented shell plating in E strake on port and starboard sides be repaired at the Owners' convenience.

The Owners, however, state that for personal reasons they have decided to withdraw the ^{class of R} vessel from the Society's Register Book.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
