S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Tug "BRUTUS" (No. 87987 in the Supplement to the Register Book), I have to acquaint you that to complete the Second Special Survey No. 1 of this vessel, which became due in September 1924, the holds and bunkers require to be examined and some repairs effected in the fore peak.

From a letter now received from the Society's Surveyors at Genoa it would appear that the tug is now on her way to Dakar, Senegal and that on her arrival there she will be sold to the "Senegal" Societe d'Approvisionnement, whose head office is in Paris, and as the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Special Survey has expired, I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain from the new Owners and let me know what arrangements they propose making for the completion of the Special Survey to receive early attention.
