Net Tonnage	143.

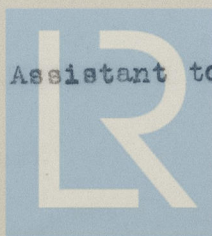
On referring to your letter of the 12th October, 1922 it is observed that you stated that the vessel was chartered for towing purposes at the port of Dakar.
