Dear Sirs,

S. I duly received your letter of the 23rd ultimo, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Havre, respecting your steamers "CABOURG" and "PARAME", and having submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the classes of these vessels the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled. The freeboard certificate for the steamer "PARAME" has been returned to this Office for cancellation by the Society's Surveyors at Havre, and I shall be obliged if you will be so good as to forward to me that issued for the steamer "CABOURG".
