I duly received your letter of the 13th instant respecting the "Sierra" vessels and in reply I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee, who had the cases before them at their Meeting to-day, have deferred consideration of the same for the present, subject to the Boiler Surveys of the "SIERRA MORENA" and "SIERRA VERDE" being carried out before the vessels are again sent to sea. The Committee are also agreeable to the Boiler Surveys of the "SIERRA MADRE" and "SIERRA NEGRA" and the Screwshaft and Boiler Surveys of the "SIERRA LEONE" being postponed for the present.

I shall be glad if you will advise me immediately you receive any further information in regard to these vessels.
