S. I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Naples have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 13th instant addressed to them relative to your Steamer "GEORGIA", from which it is noted that it is not your intention to maintain the classification of this vessel in the Society's Register Book, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee have to-day given instructions for the vessel's class to be omitted from the reprint of the Register Book, which is now taking place.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
