We are in receipt of your letter of the 17th inst. containing remarks from Wokingham regarding the above named vessel.

The following alterations should now be made in the Register Book in respect of this vessel and also the "COPIAPO" and "IMPERIAL" similarly dealt with at this port:-

Add:- (2) Deep tank No.4 hold p.&S. sides of tunnel, fwd.8' 147 tons
" " " " " " " " aft 40' 360 tons

Change:- D.B. 100 lbs to D.B. 150 lbs.

Expunge:- * Lloyd's RMC
No.3 lower hold and No.3 lower 'tweendeck for temp.
10°F. All other chambers for temp. 32°F. ("ACONCAGUA",
"COPIAPO"). For temp 32°F. ("IMPERIAL")

Expunge all details of refrigerating equipment from Register Book section pertaining to Refrigerated Steamers.

Enclosed herewith is new Capacity Plan of this and the two sister vessels which should have been forwarded with the Committee Reports on the last of these vessels dealt with. We would appreciate your forwarding this to Wokingham with your reply.
