
The year of grace allowed for the completion of the Second Special Survey No.3 expired in March, 1926. The survey has been partly held, and to complete the inspection the shell plating forward and aft requires to be dealt with, and also a number of deck plates and stringer plates, in addition to repairs to floors and intercostals etc.

Action has been deferred from time to time, and a proposal to postpone the completion of the survey until October or November, 1926, when it was stated the vessel would become due for Government Survey, was agreed to in May last.

The case received the further consideration of the Classing Committee on the 17th December, 1926, when a further postponement of the completion of the survey until January, 1927 was agreed to.

The Society's Surveyors at Kobe have now cabled that repairs have not been carried out, and the vessel is being classed with another Society, and they recommend that her classed be expunged with a black line.

The Classing Committee had the case again before them on Friday, the 13th instant, and in all the



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circumstances, instructions were given for the vessel's
class to be expunged from the Register Book with a black
line (), indicating that from reported defects she is no
longer entitled to retain her class.
