

Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Buenos Aires Surveyors have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 21st ultimo, respecting your steamer "CORVINA", for it is noted that as this vessel is now engaged in service you do not desire to maintain her as new Owners at with this Society.

In the circumstances, the recently had this case under consideration. On occasions contacted the Managers instructions for the vessel's Register Book and three dotar unwilling to carry out any Surveys indicating withdrawal of hers for further information.

Early last month I went on board the vessel whilst laid up at Buenos Aires, and the conditions so far as seen appeared generally satisfactory. Shortly afterwards she sailed and is now engaged on coastal fishing service. I feel that the new Owners have no desire to retain the class, and they have made no effort to comply with the Rule requirements.

A letter has today been addressed to the Owners intimating that I have recommended to the Committee that in view of the circumstances the notation of Lloyd's R.M.C. be expunged from the Society's Register Book.

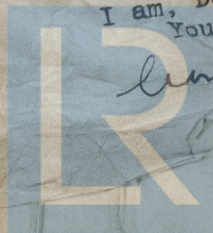
At the same time they were requested to state whether they desire to retain the Classification of this vessel and if so to submit proposals for dealing with the overdue Surveys.

After allowing a short period to receive a reply to this enquiry I will advise you further, but recommended meanwhile that the notation of Lloyd's R.M.C. be expunged from the Register Book.
