This vessel was built in 1906 in Germany, and the Buenos Aires Surveyors report that after being laid up for many years she was bought by the present owners who have lengthened her by 26' 3" forward of the machinery space.

New Dimensions:- 141.07 x 22.15 x 13.45.

It is desired to class the vessel with this Society and scantling plans and a First Entry Report have been forwarded by the Surveyors.

The scantlings and arrangements as shown have been examined and are found to be equivalent to the requirements of the Rules for full class.

The Surveyors report the approximate weight of the anchors and size and length of cable, but no particulars regarding the tests are available.

It is submitted that on completion of the survey the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A-
