I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee have to-day had under consideration Liverpool Report No. 96922 on the Steam Trawler "ISER" ex "ISA", which was referred to them by the Liverpool Committee, as intimated in your letter of the 15th instant.

With regard thereto, I am directed to acquaint you that, in the circumstances mentioned and in view of the fact that the year of grace has already been considerably exceeded, the Committee are unable to agree to any further postponement of the completion of the Second Special Survey No. 1, and have accordingly given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly convey this decision to the Owners in due course.
