J.W.ROBERTSON, Esq., LERWICK, SHETLAND.

Action in regard to these vessels has been deferred from time to time, Messrs. Stelp & Leighton having furnished the usual undertaking.

The vessels are now the property of J.W.Robertson, Esq., and in reply to inquiry Messrs. Stelp & Leighton's Representative states they were towed to Lerwick, and he understands that they are at Scapa Flow, and are being used in connexion with the salving of German War Vessels.

The new Owner was informed of the condition of the vessels' classification.
