Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant, Ref. "H", and in reply beg to state that, should we intend to put any of the Dumb Barges or Tugs, enumerated at the foot of your letter, into commission, we are agreeable that the surveys which are now overdue shall be carried out before the vessels are sent to sea; and, should we sell any of these vessels, we will inform the intending purchasers that the annual surveys are overdue.

We observe that you include the Lighter "CRETEFIELD" in the list of barges owned by us and due for survey, and we would advise you that this vessel was sold to Mr. Geoffrey Spencer, of Waterford in May last and, so far as we know, is employed by him for storage purposes at that port.
