I understand from Mr. McGilvray that the first
vessel has been completed at Aberdeen and reported and
an account for the fees has been rendered.

On enquiry Mr. McGilvray tells me that about
of the survey work has been carried out by him. The
allowing expenses in connection with the survey of this and
Concrete Vessels have so far amounted to just under £200,
in addition, Mr. McGilvray's salary has been charged to the
own accounts.

In these circumstances I would suggest that a
portion of the fees (say $\frac{4}{5}$ ths) should be credited to this
for the first vessel and that the other cases ^{in Scotland} should be
dealt with as they arise.
