Dear Sirs,

I return herewith your First Entry Report .12203 on the Ferro-Concrete Dumb Barge "CRETETREE" and with regard thereto I have to point out to you that the class of this vessel should be A1 "For English Channel and coasting Service from Thames to Milford Haven", "Subject Annual Survey", "Experimental", and I shall be glad if you will make the necessary amendments accordingly.

At the same time I shall be glad if you will forward the approved plans for this vessel, and kindly state whether the upper and bilge chines, the spacing of the beams, and the thickness of the bottom slab are as approved and if there is a bridge deck fitted the length of the same. You should also state whether the test result of the concrete at twenty-eight days is correctly given on the report, and if so whether this has been approved.

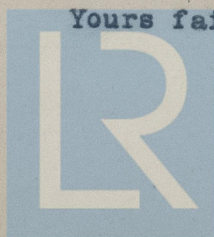
