With reference to your letter of the 25th., inst., regarding the first entry report on the machinery of the steamer "STRATHGYLE", I beg to state that the Owners inform me that the new tube plate for the condenser was fitted at Bremerhaven and is now in good order, and they were under the impression that the Engineers, who fitted same, had arranged for the Surveyors to see it completed at that port.

The vessel is now on time charter and it is difficult for the Owners to say when and where the new tube <sup>plate</sup> for the condenser can be examined, but on her return to the United Kingdom, in about six months time, arrangements will be made, which they hope will be satisfactory.
