The Undersigned surveyor to this Corporation, did, at the request of the Admiralty, attend the works of Messrs. Foster Wheeler Limited, St. Catharines, Ontario, on June 10th, 1942 and subsequently, to survey during construction and hydraulic test the Yarrow type, three drum, water tube boiler, designated Works No. C.M.B. 101, and intended to be installed under the survey of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, in Morton Engineering & Dry Dock Company Limited Hull No. 22.

The material has been tested by the surveyors to the British Corporation; the boiler scantlings are in accordance with the approved plan for a working pressure of 225 lbs. per sq. in. and the workmanship is satisfactory.

The parts of the contract which have been supplied to the shipbuilders-viz. boiler, breeches piece, and furnace fronts, were found to be satisfactory, and in accordance with the approved machinery specification.

No mountings were to hand from Sub-Contractor when the boiler was tested.
