

Dear Sir:-

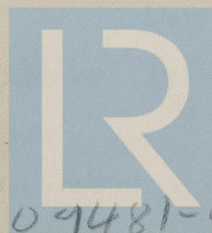

The cables have actually been designed to carry a total of 764 amperes under continuous conditions, from which it will be seen that, the area of these cables is ample for the requirements.
