GONDIM", I beg to acquaint you that the Surveyor states that the depth of the centre through keelson is as approved, viz:- $19\frac{1}{2}$ " (16 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " angle). The stiffeners on the collision bulkhead are fitted 4 " x 3 " x $.36$ " angle, with $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $.38$ " angle as approved.
