H. With reference to the Special Surveys No 1 which became due in July 1924 on the hopper barges "G.W.C. 11" and "G.W.C. 12", I have to acquaint you that these inspection have been carried out as regards the hulls of the vessels and that to complete the surveys of the donkey boilers and entitle the vessels to a record of "D.B.S. 9,24" the safety valves require to be adjusted under steam.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the new Owners and let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for the surveys in question to be completed.

I may perhaps add that these vessels are understood to have been lying up for some time past.
