For the attention of Mr. Meredith.

With reference to the conversation between Mr. Meredith and Mr. Jordan on the 12th instant respecting the cases of vessels classed with this Society and hitherto employed on Commissioned Naval Service, I beg to enclose a copy of a letter addressed from this Office to the Canadian Pacific Steamships Ltd., together with a copy of their reply in regard to the steamers "MONTCALM" and "MONTCLARE".

As it is now understood that these vessels are under Government Ownership and that the subject of the enquiry is one for the Ministry, I shall be obliged if you will kindly favour me with your comments as to the omission of the particulars and class of the vessels from the reprint of the Register Book.

I have also to refer you to the case of the motorship "PORT QUEBEC" in which the circumstances are similar and which now requires to be reviewed by the Committee as regards omission or otherwise from the reprint of the Register Book. Your remarks in this instance also would be appreciated.
