

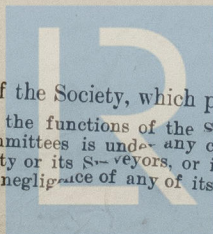
Recommended that the record of machinery remain as Classed and to have the notation of LMC (with date) NE made 1941, refitted 1/57 when the survey has been completed
