surveyed the motorship "BRITANNIA", 623 tons gross of Malta on 15th January, 1956 and subsequently on account of advancement of Special Survey, fitting additional hatch on bridge deck, converting boiler space into cargo space & fitting D.B. tank way, alterations to steering arrangements, fitting new poop superstructure, repairs to internal structure and shell plating

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all repairs commended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and

that I have Recommended that she be retained as Classed in the Register Book without fresh record of Docking and to have notation of SS Mlt (with date) when the survey has been completed, subject to being drydocked for General Examination of the windlass, internal structure in fore peak tank, repairs to p.s.f. shell plating, steering gear and chains being further examined and dealt with as necessary on arrival at Naples from Malta, also sixty fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity fit to carry dry & perishable cargo.

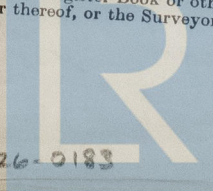
